

The University of Sydney Gives Lecture on Chinese American Relations

First Jing-dong Yuan began by analyzing and describing the economic and military policies of the two countries. Last year China accepted an invitation to participate in the Exercise of the Rim of the Pacific, which is symbolic of their efforts to cooperate together. In the future everyone will benefit if the two countries can come to an understanding.”
