Accounting Associate Professor Cheng-li Huang and Assistant Professor Fan-hua Kung attended the 21st Asian Pacific Conference on International Accounting Issues at Las Vegas, USA and won the Outstanding Paper Award with their paper “Environmental Disclosure and Stakeholder Expectation: Evidence from Taiwan” out of more than 150 competing papers.

Their paper is mainly on “Environmental Accounting,” exploring big enterprises’ environmental strategies and environmental related researches, and the president of the American Accounting Association highly praised the paper for its fresh theme. Cheng-li Huang pointed out that the Department of Accounting, Taiwan University also won such an Award in 2007, and TKU is the 2nd university in Taiwan that has won it.
