Flora Chang, you are a true 21st century educational leader. Both a futurist and a here-and-now realist, you have made Tamkang University an institution that has been honored both for academic excellence and administrative efficiency; for innovative use of information technology; and for campus safety.

Under your leadership, Tamkang has been rated "Excellent" by Taiwan's Ministry of Education and given the 19th annual Quality Award by the Ministry of Economic Affairs. The University consistently ranks among the Top 50 in Asia and as the best private university in Taiwan.

Your path began at SF State, where you earned the first of your three graduate degrees, a master's in economics. Further study at Stanford University led to a master's and a doctorate, both in education. You have held a variety of teaching and administrative posts at Tamkang University, and are now in your seventh year as its president.

Guided by a clear educational vision and strong values, you are ensuring that your students are graduating well prepared to contribute to our new global society. Multicultural awareness is a required field of study for all students. Tamkang's Cyber Campus brings the world to Taiwan, allowing your students to study online with world-renowned professors. And you have made it a priority to give Tamkang students the opportunity you had to study and live in another country. You have reached out around the world to establish educational partnerships in 28 nations, with 110 universities. One of those universities, I am proud to say, is SF State.

Flora Chang, you are far more than a gifted leader and scholar – you are a spokeswoman. At a conference on future studies you once asked, "What do we do with our new knowledge, our new technologies, and our collective consciousness?" The crucial question, you have said, is whether we can make the transition from survival to what you call *shushu* – a place of working together to create a new future for the planet.

Despite the demands of leading Tamkang University's four campuses, you remain an active teacher and scholar, writing and speaking on subjects as diverse as gender equity in faculty hiring in Taiwan; distance education; quality and cost efficiency; strategies for university governance; and building a "greener" campus.
