Encouraging Students to Gain Accreditation

To encourage students to actively obtain professional licenses in the field of finance and banking, the Department of Banking and Finance set up a Securities Trading Lab in the College of Business Building (B1012). In addition, from November 2009, TKU has gone about purchasing an ever—expanding question database. At present, it has 11 sets of databases. Starting from 2010, it has incorporated such databases into a number of department courses, including "Investment Securities in Practice", "Investing", "Guidance in Obtaining a Financial Planning License", and "Fixed—income Securities". During such courses, students are given mock exams to test their knowledge and help them to acquire finance—related accreditations.

The Chair of the Department of Banking and Finance, Dr. Chiu Chien-liang, noted: "At present, the global financial environment is extremely competitive. We therefore hope that before students graduate, they can first obtain formal finance—related accreditations so as to enhance their competitiveness in the workforce."
