There was also a speech from the President of the ROC, Mr. Ma Ying—Jeou.

Fourth year Department of Russian student, Wu Pei—ying, said that in class, Mr. Huang often talks about issues from a humanistic perspective. "Originally, I thought that these issues were just a part of history, but now I realize that many historical issues have yet to be solved."
