

International Student Entrance Scholarships Awarded as VP Chen Encourages Students to Serve as Bridges Between Taiwan and the World

To encourage outstanding international students to enroll at Tamkang University, the Office of International and Cross-Strait Affairs held the “2025 Academic Year International Student Entrance Scholarship Award Ceremony” at 10:20 a.m. on December 19 at the Ching-Sheng International Conference Hall. Vice President for International Affairs Hsiao-Chuan Chen attended the ceremony, along with deans of the colleges of the award recipients, department chairs, and heads of relevant administrative units. In her opening remarks, Vice President Chen thanked the students for choosing to study at Tamkang University and welcomed them to the Tamkang family. She noted that during their academic journey, students not only accumulate professional knowledge but also gain valuable experiences through interaction and exchange with peers from different countries, allowing them to engage with diverse cultures. Such experiences, she emphasized, help shape personal qualities and lay a strong foundation for future development. By awarding scholarships, Tamkang University aims to alleviate students’ financial burdens, enabling them to focus on their studies and personal growth.
